TO OPERATE ON A NON-PROFIT BASIS TO: (a) educate Association members and aspiring conformation judges, to increase their knowledge, and otherwise advance and enhance judging at conformation dog shows wherever members may officiate; and (b) liaise with the CKC and provide an advisory service with respect to all programs and policies pertaining to conformation dog judging; and (c) support conscientious and knowledgeable conformation dog judging in accordance with CKC and other international breed standards to preserve the essence, purpose and critical characteristics of breeds as established in their country of origin and perpetuated in various countries of development around the world; and (d) carry on such other business as is ancillary to the main objectives.
